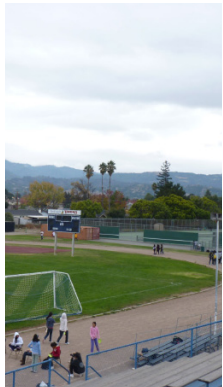


area ten HOLIDAY PARTY FOR THE HOMELESS

WHERE: CalSkate of Milpitas

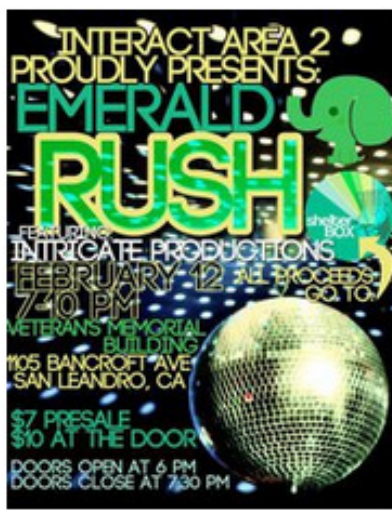
